MOAA-WG MILITARY HISTORIAN SPEAKER BILL HYNDMAN FOR PROGRAM ON 21 MAY 2015 –VE CLUB -1200 HOURS

American Military History Program Introduction

From the icy winters at Valley Forge to the steaming jungles of Vietnam--from the bloody beaches at Normandy to the sweltering sands of Iraq, liberty-loving men and women have fought to preserve American freedom.

Campaign medals are awarded to those who serve in a particular theater of war; battle stars are awarded to those who participate in specific battles; the bronze arrowhead is awarded for participation in an initial assault landing or combat parachute jump. Other medals and awards are also given to acknowledge extraordinary sacrifices and acts of bravery.

Through the years, William Lee Hyndman has been privileged to meet personally with some of our greatest defenders of freedom. They range from his friend Roy Benavidez who received the Congressional Medal of Honor in Vietnam, the highest American award for combat valor, to a man he met in Sterling, New Jersey who received five battle stars and a bronze arrowhead. Bill honors them all by keeping their stories alive.

When asked the reason he does veterans displays and accepts speaking engagements he replied, "From the citizen soldier walking barefoot through the snow at Morristown to the soldier walking with his boots rotted off through the mud and mire of Vietnam, personal sacrifice has been the price of liberty--and I'm privileged to enjoy that liberty. What I do is little enough for what all our veterans have done in whatever capacity they served. "

Bills magnificent displays and heartfelt words are a tribute to the hardships endured in the preservation of our freedom by all who have served, in all wars, from all branches of our military services.

LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS UPDATE BY: MAJ Thomas Sadowski, USAF-R

- REPRESENTATIVE JOE WILSON (R-S.C.) introduced H.R. 1594, the Military Surviving Spouse Equity Act. The bill repeals a law known as the "widow's tax," an unfair penalty that forces thousands of military survivors to forfeit their earned benefits. Under current law, military survivors forfeit part of or their entire military Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) annuity when receiving Dependency and Indemnity Compensation (DIC) from the Department of Veterans Affairs.
- VETERANS AFFAIRS FUTUERE BUDGET BILL PASSAGED The House agreed to a motion to suspend the rules and pass the bill, as amended, that would direct the Veterans Affairs Department to annually submit to Congress a future-years veterans program with its budget request. The program would reflect estimated expenditures and proposed appropriations for that fiscal year and succeeding four fiscal years, and would include a five-year plan for the department to meet its commitment to veterans, including the resources needed to do so
- SEN. TOOMEY HONORS VIETNAM WAR VETERANS IN CONGRESSIONAL RECORD Senator Toomey is cosponsoring a resolution recognizing 29 MARCH as Vietnam Veterans day!
- HOUSE PASSES MEDICARE PAYMENT FORMULA On Mar. 26, the House overwhelmingly passed a bipartisan measure by a vote of 392-37 that would permanently fix the flawed payment formula that provides payments to physicians who see Medicare patients. (Source: Congressman Patrick Meehan News Letter, March 27, 2015).
- The Obama administration is working with the MCRMC to refine specific proposals and will report its findings to Congress by April 30. The MCRMC's retirement proposal recommends service members will receive a 20 percent reduction in military retired pay, in addition to matching government contributions in the federal Thrift Savings Plan. The commission also recommends privatizing TRICARE, with military family members and retirees moving into a health care system similar to one used by federal civilians.
