Our guest speaker, **COL George Wingfield**, a Penn State ROTC graduate commissioned in the Field Artillery and a member of the US Army War College class of 2014, provided a very informative presentation on the role of the Army in space.

For those of us who have been away from it for a while, I guess we shouldn't be surprised about the need for satellites to provide location and direction for all our vehicles and precision guided munitions, not to mention the point-to-point communications. COL Wingfield laid out the organization and capabilities of the Army Space and Missile Defense Command that conducts space and missile defense operations and provides planning, integration, control and coordination of Army forces and capabilities in support of U.S. Strategic Command missions of strategic deterrence, integrated missile defense, and space operations. The command also serves as the Army force modernization proponent for space, high altitude and global missile defense and as the Army operational integrator for global missile defense while conducting mission-related research and development in support of Army. He very ably answered member questions -- including an answer to Bob Chant's question, "Where would Buck Rogers be assigned in today's military?"

Dean Weissman has served since 1998 as dean of the college and since 2002 as provost. He joined Dickinson in 1975 as an instructor in history and went on to rise through the ranks of assistant, associate and full professor. He has served as chair of the Department of History; coordinator of the Russian and Soviet Area Studies, International Studies and East Asian Studies programs; director of the Clarke Center for the Interdisciplinary Study of Contemporary Issues; and project director for international education. Dean Weissman received his undergraduate degree *summa cum laude* as valedictorian from Colgate University and holds master's and doctoral degrees in Russian history from Princeton University. He is a published scholar in the field of Russian and Soviet history, working on issues of government, policing and deviance.

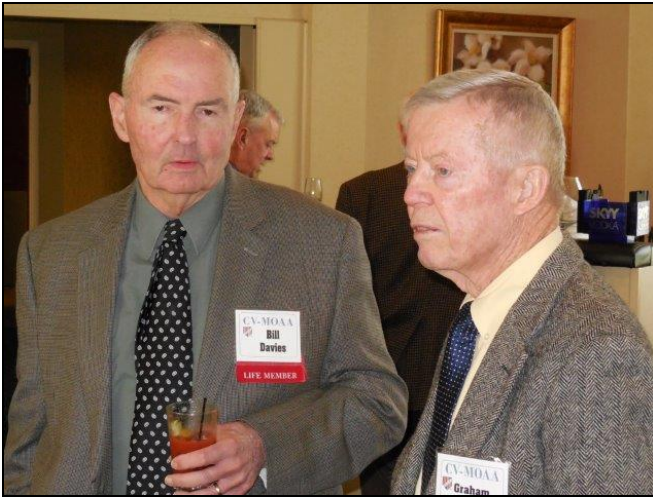
