• **Our President's Biography:**

Our new President, LTC Bill Confer Sr, USA (Ret), introduced himself as the incoming president and a Vietnam Helicopter Pilot. He served seven and one-half years on active duty from 1966 to 1973.

He came back home to Lock Haven Pennsylvania, finished College and almost immediately joined the National Guard serving as a Battalion Training Officer/Materiel Officer/and a Battalion Executive Officer until moving to Fort Indiantown Gap where he took over as the Chief of Maintenance for the State Surface Maintenance Manager for the Pennsylvania Army National Guard both fulltime and part-time.

At Fort Indiantown Gap he managed a \$10,000,000 maintenance budget and some 350 fulltime soldiers in 22 Maintenance Facilities across the state, retiring in 2002 with almost 36 years total service. Continuing as a contractor for the Guard for master planning, he served until 2010 and continued to do some part-time work for another year or so and finally retired.

He has four Children, seven grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Bill lives at Brethren

Village with his wife Helen. They have been married 54 years.

Awards and Decorations include the Legion of Merit, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star, the Purple Heart, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Air Medal with 35 Oak Leaf Clusters, the Army Commendation Medal with the V device, the good conduct medal, the Vietnam Campaign Medal with 4 stars, the Vietnam Service Medal and various other state awards and the Samuel Sharpe Master Gunner of Ordnance Medal.
