MOAA National has released a quarterly report listing by State and by Chapter how many members are registered on MOAA's Legislative Action Center. It also provides the number of actions taken on issues contacting members of congress.

Keystone Capital Chapter does not look good when you see less than 10 members registered and 21 actions taken from a 40-member chapter. While anyone can go on the MOAA website and use the MOAA Legislative Action Center, MOAA Chapter members need to register and list what chapter they belong to for tracking.
