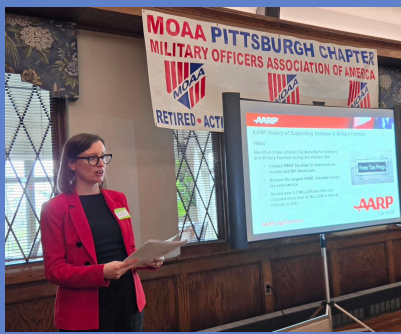

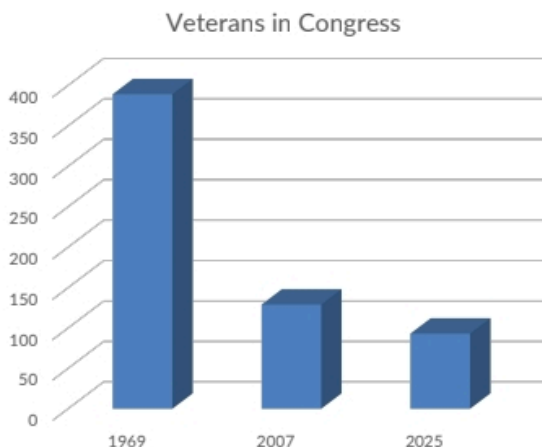

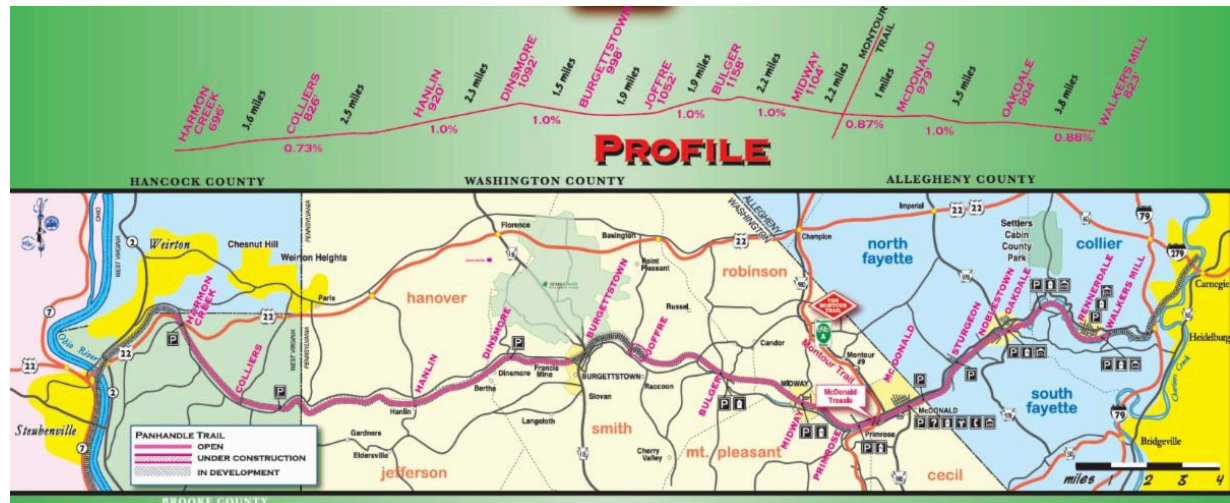

New Immigration Process at Bases in Europe

The European Union (EU) has begun a phased rollout of its electronic Entry/Exit System (EES). Implementation started in October 2025 and is scheduled to finish by 10 April 2026.

EES is an automated system that registers non-EU nationals visiting for short stays and replaces passport stamps. For full, accurate details, please [visit the official website](#).

This week, border control agents at the Ramstein AB passenger terminal began using EES. Since this is a new system, passengers may encounter delays. If you're planning to [fly Space-A to or from Ramstein](#), pack your patience!

The NAVSTA Rota passenger terminal will implement EES at a later date. Space-A travel to Rota remains restricted, and I do not have any indication that EES will change that policy. ([This article](#) explains the restrictions and other details about flying Space-A via Rota).

Ramstein and Rota matter most for Space-A travelers because those bases have the most frequent direct flights between Europe and the United States. I will share

updates about EES implementation at other EU passenger terminals as they become available.

Also, note that Europe's electronic travel authorization, ETIAS, is scheduled to launch in Q4 of this year. Learn about ETIAS and how it differs from EES [on the official website](#).

Travel Benefits for Disabled Veterans

Veterans with any service-connected disability rating, including 0%, can use many of the travel-related benefits discussed on Poppin' Smoke, even if the veteran is not retired from the military.
